The new Orthopaedic Centre at Llandough Hospital, Penarth comprises a two-storey wing of 12,600 sq ft per floor that was built to replace temporary accommodation. Holder Mathias designed a contemporary-style building which provides state-of-the-art facilities for NHS patients in the Cardiff & Vale NHS Trust.

The ground floor is given over predominantly to out-patient care while on the first floor are four complete operating suites including laminar air-flow specialist theatres, preparation, scrub and anesthetic rooms and other out-patient support areas, reception and overnight-stay beds. Particular attention has been paid to making the facility easy to clean to reduce the possibility of MRSA infection.
