This building was designed by Holder Mathias in association with Takanaka (UK) Ltd to provide production space for the manufacture and assembly of electronic typewriters and printers, warehousing and office space.

The 10,000 sqm steel framed building was the first in the UK to use vitreous enamel steel cladding panels measuring 3m x 1.5m.

Careful attention was paid to the external design and the surrounding landscape because of the building's proximity to the Grade I listed Tredegar House. The project took thirteen months from initial briefing to handover for production.
